



Education – Policy

SpringDale Neighbourhood House aims to provide learning opportunities for the wider community by building confidence through education and training. SpringDale is an independent not for profit community organisation.

This is achieved by offering a wide range of formal and informal programs for adults, children and families that include special interest groups, community service activities, workshops and other informal groups.

Although SpringDale is not a Registered Training Organisation some classes are conducted by accredited trainers who are trained and current in their field.

Some courses attract Learn Local Funding which need to meet a certain criteria in line with the annual Learn Local Delivery Plan. The aim of these courses is to equip students with skills to assist them with study, work and life.

All students are encouraged to complete a survey on completion of their course. All tutors and leaders complete assessments and record attendances. As part of the Learn Local Service Agreement, data is collated and reported to SVTS (Skills Victoria Training System)
